





1. INSTALL CABINET WALL BRACKETS



TIP HAZARD WARNING! Cabinet MUST be affixed to wall.




- Install cage-nut (T) onto mount in two locations shown in the illustration below.
- B Loosely mount Bracket (Q) using Screw (A), Washer (R) and cage-nut (T).

2. LEVEL CABINET & MARK WALL

Prior to fastening to wall, it is important to level the cabinet with the floor by verifying that feet are properly adjusted.

Check and level length and depth of cabinet.






Loosen jam nut with supplied wrench and tighten to the locked position.




Place cabinet in desired location and mark bracket holes. Once holes have been marked move cabinet.

NOTE:

Adjustments has been provided in the bracket to mount the cabinet 0-1" of the wall to account for baseboard trim or other obstacles.




3. CAMERA SHELF (OPTIONAL)



D Place Camera


Use double side tape to secure camera from sliding off shelf.





4. INSTALL WALL FASTENERS (MOST APPLICATIONS)

Install wall fasteners to marked location on wall & fasten cabinet.


NOTE: Alternate fasteners provided for wood or masonry installation.








Hold ends of straps between thumb and forefinger and pull toward you until channel rests flush behind wall.
Slide plastic cap along straps with either hand with flange of cap is flush with wall.



Snap straps at wall by pushing side to side, snapping of straps level with flange of cap.



Move cabinet to wall and attach bracket. Insert bolt through Bracket and tighten until snug against wall.


4. INSTALL WALL FASTENERS (ALTERNATE)

WOOD: Locate two framing studs using a stud finder device.


MASONRY: Place brackets in desired location.

WOOD: Use a 3/16" [5mm] drill bit and drill holes 2.5" [64mm] deep.


MASONRY: Use a 3/8" [10mm] drill bit and drill holes 2.5" [64mm] deep.



C Insert wall anchors (M) into hole.




Place cabinet in place and fasten with washers (P) and Lag Bolts (D).



5. INSTALL BRUSH SEAL



Use with baseboard molding, trim work or gaps in uneven wall surfaces. Brush Seal Holders should stay flush to surface so that ONLY brush is showing.




6. INSTALL DISPLAY BRACKETS



Install Washer to Brackets

Affix shoulder washer (S) to Interface bracket (W) with screw (J) on the top and bottom hole as shown.

Note position of washer relative to bracket.






Attach Brackets to Display

Fasten the brackets using fasteners (length and size recommended by the display manufacturer. *Using improper screw length can damage the display.*

NOTE:


Other displays may use different screw lengths.

M8 16mm screws are supplied for use with Microsoft Surface Hub.



6. INSTALL DISPLAY BRACKETS


Using the key slots provided on mount face, slide display into place.



7. ADJUSTING DISPLAY TILT ANGLE (OPTIONAL)


Mount tilt is preset at factory. If adjustment is necessary, remove display, loosen bolts (V) and adjust bolts (K) in three locations to achieve proper tilt. Do not over tighten screw (V).


Adjusting screws (K) will tilt mount. Screws (V) hold mount in desired position



8. INSTALL SHELVES

- **A.** Shelf placement can be adjusted if necessary to either predrilled locations or any location using Drop-In Nuts (N) Shelf Peg assembly (see diagram below).
- B. Place shelves on pegs.
- **C.** Install shelf stops in front or back of shelf as desired.
- **D.** Install accessories (IR Repeater Kit, Power Conditioner, etc) and place components.








MODESTY PANEL

Removing and Re-Installing


NOTE: Be sure bottom of modesty panel is flush to cabinets top.






Insert Drop-In Nut (N) into the slots of the vertical mounting post and using the provided Hex Key.

3U VERTICAL RACK



Remove


Loosen screws on both sides. Then tilt rack until the hook is free and lift up until the rack is free from bottom screw.



Re-Install



Slide the slotted ends of the rack over the bottom screw and hook the top screw as shown.






Tighten with provided Hex Key.

DOORS

NOTE: It is important that cabinet is level before adjusting doors, see step 2.
