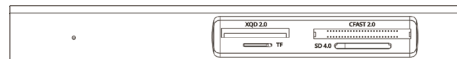

2. **Card reader:**
 - XQD 2.0 supports 400MB/s
 - CFast 2.0 supports 500MB/s
 - TF/Micro SD (UHS-I) supports 104MB/s
 - SD 4.0 (UHS-II) supports 280MB/s



3. LAN:

Gigabit Ethernet port
(Full Duplex 10/100/1000 Mbps)

4. USB 3.0 Typ-A:

Connect to USB device
(5 Gbps, support BC1.2 charging 5V/1.5A)

5. Thunderbolt 3 Host:

Connect to Thunderbolt 3 of laptop
support PD 60W charging

6. Thunderbolt 3 port:

Connect to Thunderbolt 3 device
40Gbps, PD 5V/3A

7. DisplayPort 1.4:

Connect to DP monitor
support single 8K output (max)

8. Power Jack:

DC 24V/5A

NOTE:

- Thunderbolt 3 - 40 Gbit/s have to use the cable which support Thunderbolt 3 40G. Please use attached Thunderbolt 3 cable or other Thunderbolt 3 active cables.
- In Windows 10 you might see a pop-up message requesting permission to allow the docking to connect to your computer. If you see this pop-up message, select Always Connect from the list and click OK. If required, follow any other on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
